It has been many years since Henley has held a Pancake Race. This is going to be a fun morning for everyone but at the same time I would like to raise funds for my chosen charities. They are the Charles "Berti" Bertoli Staying Alive Foundation and the Henley Youth Centre.

About the charities:

Charles "Berti" Bertoli Staying Alive Foundation is an appeal under the Reading & District Hospitals Charity (Charity No 1007779) raising funds for the Renal Unit of the Royal Berkshire Hospital. The Foundation was set up in loving memory of Charles by a group of friends who were determined to do something positive and lasting after he was tragically killed in January 1996 whilst a passenger in a car accident. The Foundation has to date raised over £90,000 in Berti's name. The next target is to raise £35,000 for a SonoSite 180Plus ultrasound scanner. This amazing machine provides high-resolution imaging that enables the medical team to perform kidney biopsies and other precision procedures necessary for dialysis patients.

Henley Youth Centre provides a much needed facility for the young people of Henley. The building is run and owned by the Thamesfield Youth Association. We are endeavouring to upgrade the facilities at the Centre which is being used on a very regular basis and we wish to offer better facilities for youth clubs, dance clubs, for all including those with disabilities, local homework groups, etc. The fabric of the building inside has been modernized but we need to furnish it with tables, chairs, sofas. We also need more worker time and volunteers to help run the many clubs that are required.

The event will start at 10.30 and will be run as a knock-out competition

Fancy Dress may be worn and there will be a competition

RULES OF A PANCAKE RACE

- Complete the registration form and return
- Teams will consist of 6 entrants
- You may enter as many teams as you wish.
- In order to enter sponsorship of no less than £5 per person must be obtained (£30 to be available on the 20th February 2010)
- Sponsorship will be gained for the number of flips of pancake per team per race
- Your sponsorship forms must be brought with you so we can ascertain funds raised.
- Sponsorship money should be collected by the 1st March 2010
- There will be 4 categories of race; Primary School age, Secondary School age, Adults and over 70's
- All entrants must flip their pancake at least four times per lap.
- Laps will consist of 6 x 50 metres run in relay
- This will be a knock out competition so more than one race may be required
- All teams must bring their own frying pan of a maximum size of 9" (22 cm)
- Pancakes will be provided and will be of similar size for all entrants
- In the event of a dispute the Mayor's decision will be final
- All children to be supervised by an adult
